**DISCUSSION ITEM E:** Merit and Loan Forgiveness Programs Status Report

**Staff Recommendation:** For information only.

**Background:** The Dependent Children Scholarship, Minority Teaching Fellows, Ned McWherter Scholars, and Tennessee Teaching Scholars are state funded programs administered by TSAC. The Robert C. Byrd Honors Scholarship is a federally funding program also administered by TSAC. TSAC also administers the Tennessee Graduate Nursing Loan Forgiveness program, funded by private resources.

Current 2008-09 data indicate that 1,139 students will receive \$3,277,094, although these amounts will decline as certification rosters are completed.
