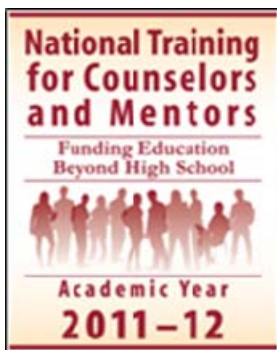
# High School Counselors and Mentors Workshop

**T**SAC is once again sponsoring the National Training for Counselors and Mentors (NT4CM) workshops. Training sessions will start in late October. National Training for Counselors and Mentors (NT4CM) is a **FREE** one-day training program that is designed to provide counselors and mentors with comprehensive up-to-date information regarding federal and state aid programs. In addition to gaining up-to-date information, materials, and resources regarding federal and state student aid programs, participants will also have valuable opportunities to

network and share knowledge and experiences with other peers in their profession. This training will provide information and materials that will help in effectively advising students and their families about how to prepare financially for college. NT4CM is appropriate for any individual who advises students and their families about pursuing education beyond high school.

Members of the TSAC and THEC staff will be in attendance at each workshop to provide updated information about the state grant and lottery scholarship programs, and new college access initiatives that are being implemented.

# High School Peer Counselor Program

**T**he High School Peer Counselor Program provides an opportunity for college students to work in the high school counselor offices during the Spring semester of the academic year. Each institution that chooses to participate in the program must train the students to assist with completing financial aid applications and scholarship searches before they can begin work.

The institution pays the peer counselor(s) according to the terms of the state contract and submits invoice(s) for reimbursement from TSAC. The deadline to submit your application is October 31, 2010.
