Rules and Regulations Governing Horse Trail Use

- All rules and regulations will be enforced by TWRA.
- All horse riders will stay on designated trail.
- All horse riders must have valid Coggins papers with them while riding.
- No riding will be permitted off trail in woods, streams, river and fields.
- No dogs allowed while riding.
- No alcohol permitted while riding.
- No littering.
- All horse riders riding off trails (such as up steep embankments next to hills, rivers, or streams) will be giving a citation and/or removed from the property.
- It is highly recommended during hunting season, that riders wear blaze orange clothing for safety.
