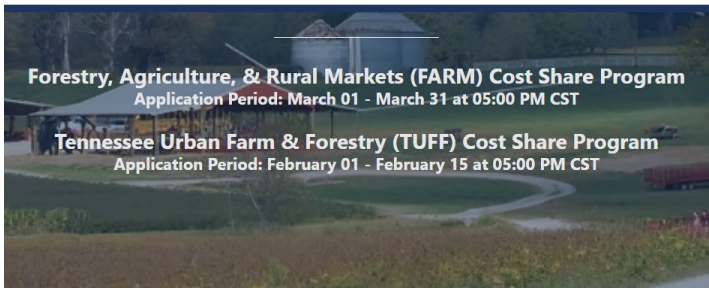
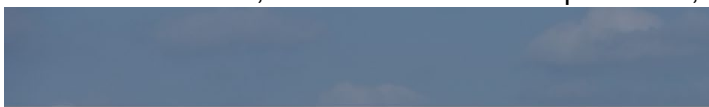
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Logging In

Initial Login

1. Applicants will be required to create an account within the application portal to complete and submit an application. The application portal can be accessed at the following web address: <https://horne2.outsystemsenterprise.com/TNAgriculture/Login>. The first step in the account creation process will be to click “Register” as shown below.
2. After clicking “Create Account”, a registration page will open that the applicant will be required to complete with their user information and desired password. Please note that passwords must be at least 8 characters, include at least one capital letter, and include at least one numeric character.

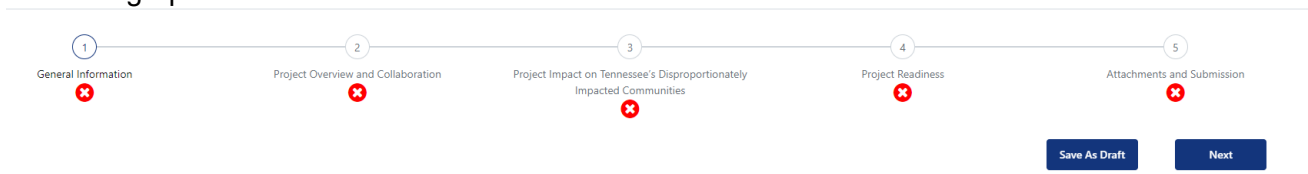


Portal Navigation Overview

- Once an applicant has successfully logged into their portal account, they will be able to begin completing their TUFF application. To access the application form, click the "New Application" button shown in the top right of your screen and select TUFF, as shown below.



- This will redirect the applicant to the first section of the application form. The application consists of 5 sections which all must be completed to submit the form. Once a section has been completed, the red X will become a green check mark to indicate that all required fields have been completed. If any section shows a red X, the application cannot be submitted. Applicants can move through the application sections by either clicking the "Next" button or clicking on the desired section in the progress tracker graphic shown below.



- The application can be saved at any point by clicking the "Save as Draft" button. This will save all progress on the application form and allow the user to resume working on the form at a later time.

Application Instructions and Overview

1. General Information

- I. The General Information section of the application requires the applicant to provide general information about their business entity and contact information. All fields marked as required must be completed to successfully submit the application.
- II. This section includes a field for **Unique Entity Identifier (UEI)**. Please note this is not a required field for the application, but your business will need one for their grant contract if chosen to receive funds. We recommend starting the application process now to ensure your business has a UEI and will be able to receive to the TUFF Cost Share portion if your application is selected. Please go the TN TUFF website, scroll down to just above the Recorded Webinar, and click on the two blue UEI resource buttons on to review instructions on how to register. Tennessee Urban Farm and Forestry (TUFF)

The Tennessee Department of Agriculture developed the Tennessee Urban Farm and Forestry (TUFF) cost share program as an opportunity to increase agricultural and forestry production in disadvantaged areas within Tennessee's urban communities. The program will sponsor projects that improve the overall health of these communities by meeting nutritional needs, providing education about healthy food, and increasing agricultural production and forest products from urban small businesses. TUFF is made possible by the State of Tennessee's American Rescue Plan funding through the State and Local Fiscal Recovery Fund.

Eligible expenses include those that support new projects or improvements to operations that are not a part of normal business operations. Projects must either:

1. Promote the health of Tennessee's urban communities through increased access to or education about nutritious food.

OR

2. Aid in the expansion of urban farming and forestry small businesses through increased production of agricultural commodities and forest products.

TUFF cost share program funding will be reimbursement based and cover up to 50% of approved project expenses or a maximum amount of \$250,000 and the awardee will be responsible for providing matching funds covering the remaining portion of the proposed project expenses.

Application evaluation criteria will include:

- Project sustainability
- Impact on the community
- Collaboration with community partners
- Project readiness

The application period for the second round of TUFF funding is Feb. 1 - 15, 2024.

- II. The Collaboration section includes the following question:
 - a. Have you collaborated with any industry or community partners on this project to ensure the success and meaningful impact on the state's supply chain? (i.e., key suppliers, finished product consumers, institutes of higher learning/universities, industry/trade associations, other businesses/entities, consultants, financial advisors, government agencies, etc.)
 - i. If answered "Yes", then please fill out the required collaboration partner table shown below. To create additional collaborators, click the blue button "Add Contact" on the right-hand side of the page. To describe the nature of collaboration, please click on the blue pencil icon located in that section.
 - ii. If answered "No", the collaboration table will be hidden, and you can move to the next section.

3. Project Impact on Tennessee's Disproportionately Impacted Communities

- I. Section 3 of the application will require applicants to explain their project's impact on Tennessee's disproportionately impacted communities, along with identifying which of the two program objectives the project most aligns with:
 - a. Project promotes the health of Tennessee's urban communities through increased access to or education about agricultural products.
 - b. Project aids your small business in the production of agricultural commodities including forest products.
- II. Upon selection of either program objective, you will be required to describe how your project will increase access to or education about fresh fruits and vegetables, or, how your project will increase your small business' production of agricultural commodities.
 - a. If your project will be promoting access to or education about agricultural products, you will be asked to specify how many individuals you expect to impact and define which populations you expect to impact and how your project will serve them.
 - b. If your project will be aiding your small business in production of agricultural commodities, you will be asked to describe how your project will increase your production and to describe how your project will impact the supply of agricultural or forest products in urban areas of the state of Tennessee. You will be asked whether your project will create new jobs and by what percentage your business' operational capacity will increase.
- III. This section will require you to describe your plan to maintain your project's community impact over the next five years.

4. Project Readiness

- I. The Project Readiness section of the application will require the applicant to provide information about their project's budget, the amount of TUFF cost share funding being requested, cost share match sources, and expected timeline. All fields marked as required must be completed to successfully submit the application.
- II. This section includes three tables that must be completed. Instructions for each table are as follows:
 - a. Budget
 - i. Provide information related to each budget item for your project in the table provided. Note that each field is required for every budget line item. Additional lines can be added to the table by clicking the blue "Add Budget Line" button to the right.
