**1. APPROVAL OF THE JUNE 23, 2015 COMMISSION MEETING MINUTES**

**Discussion/Action Taken:** Commissioner Jones motioned for approval and Commissioner Kaegi seconded the motion; the motion passed with 2 ayes.

**2. RETAIL MATTERS****A. NEW BUSINESS**

**1. EAST END LIQUORS  
 FAYETTEVILLE, TENNESSEE (LINCOLN COUNTY)**

Applicant: Kevin W. Hargrave, Sole Proprietor

Current: Linda J. Wolaver, d/b/a East End Liquors (Permit No. 3535)

Proposed: Kevin W. Hargrave, d/b/a East End Liquors

Before the Commission is a request for a transfer of ownership regarding the package store located at 122 B. Shelbyville Hwy., Fayetteville, TN 37334. The applicant plans to purchase the business from the current owner for \$80,000.<sup>1</sup> As verified by TABC staff, financing for the business will come from a bank loan. A lease is not required as Mr. Hargrave owns the real property where the business is located. The TABC staff recommends conditional approval of this request, subject to receipt of the following items:

**2. MIDWAY LIQUORS  
MEMPHIS, TENNESSEE (SHELBY COUNTY)**

Applicant: Joy L. Smith, Sole Proprietor

Previous: Kent Smith, d/b/a Midway Liquors (License No. 0240 expired on 05/11/15)

Before the Commission is a request for the applicant, Joy Smith, to obtain licensing for the retail store previously owned by her husband, Kent Smith, who is now deceased. Kent Smith left his wife all property per his Last Will and Testament.<sup>2</sup> Ms. Smith will lease the premises from Loeb Bros. Realty, L.P. for a term of two years and eleven months at a monthly rental rate of approximately \$1,200. The TABC staff recommends conditional approval of this request, subject to receipt of the following items:

- b. TN Sales Tax #
- c. TTB Dealer's Permit

Before the Commission is a request for a change in shareholders and shareholder interest in the retail business located at 13044 Kingston Pike, Farragut, Tennessee 37934. Linda Taylor is the owner of all (194.00) voting shares and plans to give all of her nonvoting shares (187.650) to her four children. Three of the four are already nonvoting stockholders (owning 122.310 shares each), and Andrew Taylor will be the only new stockholder. Ms. Taylor is gifting Andrew Taylor 138.645 nonvoting shares, and the other

three children will receive 16.335 nonvoting shares each. The TABC staff recommends approval of this request.

BAXTER, TENNESSEE (PUTNAM COUNTY)**

Applicant: Shanti I Inc.  
Shareholder(s): Ritesh Patel, 100%

Current: Chris R. Mabey (sole proprietor), d/b/a Midstate Wine & Spirits (License No. 3696)  
Proposed: Shanti I Inc., d/b/a Midstate Wine & Spirits

Before the Commission is a request for a transfer of ownership regarding the retail business located at 115 Fast Lane, Baxter, Tennessee 38544. If approved, the applicant will purchase the inventory (via licensed TN wholesaler involvement) from the current owner for an amount not to exceed \$180k. Financing for the purchase will come from a bank loan in the amount of approximately \$180k, as verified by TABC staff. The applicant will lease the premises from Tenn Reit, LLC, for an initial term of ten years at a monthly rental rate of \$5,000.<sup>4</sup> The TABC staff recommends conditional approval of this request, subject to receipt of the following items:

- c. License Fee

Applicant: 4W Enterprises, LLC

Before the Commission is a request for approval of an expansion of the retail store located at 921C N. Hwy 92, Jefferson City, Tennessee 37760. The additional space will be used for storage and an office. Per an addendum to the lease, the applicant is leasing the premises (including the additional space) from Pamela S. Murph, at a monthly rental rate of \$1,300.<sup>5</sup> The TABC staff

Applicant: EZ In & Out Liquor, LLC<sup>7</sup>

Before the Commission is a request for licensing of a new retail store to be located at 4425 Broadway, Knoxville, Tennessee 37917. Ms. Crowley will be investing \$50,000 into the business, as verified by TABC staff. The applicant will lease the premises from William E. Monday for an initial term of one year (with an additional five year extension option) at a monthly rental rate of \$1,250. The TABC staff recommends conditional approval of this request, pending receipt of the following items:

Before the Commission is a request for licensing of a new retail store to be located at 940 Richards Road, #104, Antioch, Tennessee 37013. Ms. Patel is borrowing \$175k (at 5% per annum) from Kalia S. Patel to invest into the business, as verified by TABC staff. The applicant is leasing the premises from Mill Creek Commons, LLC for an initial term of 39 months at a monthly rental rate of approximately \$4,000.<sup>8</sup> The TABC staff recommends conditional approval of this request, subject to receipt of the following items:

- a. TABC Inspection
- b. Acknowledgement of TABC Rules/Regulations
- c. Certificate of Occupancy or letter from metro stating the location is approved for occupancy
- d. License Fee

Before the Commission is a request for a transfer of ownership regarding the retail package store located at 412 N. Gateway Avenue, Rockwood, Tennessee 37854. The applicant plans to purchase the assets (including inventory) from the seller for a purchase price of \$50k (the price will be adjusted based on an inventory examination).<sup>13</sup> Baldevbhai S. Patel is loaning his son, Sanjaykumar Patel, \$100k (at 3% per annum) to invest into the business. The applicant will lease the premises from James Gregory Williams for an initial term of two years at a monthly rental rate of \$1,500. The TABC staff recommends conditional approval of this request, subject to receipt of the following items:

**1. TEMPLE HILLS COUNTRY CLUB  
FRANKLIN, TENNESSEE (WILLIAMSON COUNTY)**

Applicant: Temple Hills CC, LLC

Before the Commission is a request for a transfer of ownership regarding the for-profit, private club located at 6376 Temple Road, Franklin, Tennessee 37069. The club has 679 members, each paying \$330 for monthly dues. The applicant meets the requirements of T.C.A §57-4-102(8)(J).<sup>15</sup> Temple Hills CC, LLC, is purchasing the club from the seller for approximately six million dollars using current operating funds and will lease the premises from ClubCorp NV XIII, LLC

for an initial term of five years at a monthly rental rate of approximately \$24k.<sup>16</sup> The TABC staff recommends conditional approval of this request, subject to receipt of the following items:

- b. Copy of club by-laws

**Discussion/Action Taken:** Commissioner Jones motioned for conditional approval, subject to receipt of missing items. Commissioner Kaegi seconded the motion and the motion passed with 2 ayes. Update: License # 99484 issued 7.24.15

## 8. INITIAL ORDERS TO BE REVIEWED BY THE COMMISSION

### A. Tennessee Alcoholic Beverage Commission v. Jessica Hill – Docket No. 33.05-129784J

Ms. Hill's application for server permit was denied by TABC staff for having been convicted of a prohibited offense. Ms. Hill requested an administrative hearing and the hearing was held on June 9, 2015. On July 1, 2015, Administrative Law Judge Kim Summers issued an I/O ordering Ms. Hill's application for a server permit be "approved and granted." Pursuant to T.C.A § 4-5-315, an Initial Order is to be reviewed by the TABC. The TABC staff does not oppose the Commission's affirmation and confirmation of Judge Summers' Initial Order.

**Discussion/Action Taken:** Commissioner Jones motioned to uphold Judge Summer's I/O. Commissioner Kaegi seconded the motion, and the motion was approved with two ayes.

## 9. SERVER APPEAL

### A. Nayeli Alejandra Reyes Carrillo

Ms. Reyes Carillo applied for a TABC server permit on 05/20/15. Pursuant to T.C.A. § 4-58-103, state agencies are required to verify that each applicant who applies for a state benefit is a United States citizen or is lawfully present in the United States, and as such Ms. Carrillo's Employment Authorization Card was entered into the Department of Homeland Security's SAVE program (Systematic Alien Verification for Entitlements). On 06/09/2015 it was confirmed via SAVE that Ms. Reyes Carrillo is classified as DACA (Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals). As stated by U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services, "deferred action is a discretionary determination to defer a removal action of an individual as an act of prosecutorial discretion." Deferred action does not confer lawful status, and as such, Ms. Reyes Carrillo is not "qualified" for a public benefit - in this case - an employee/server permit issued by the TABC. The TABC staff mailed a denial letter

to the applicant on 06/09/2015, and on 07/07/2015, the TABC received a letter from the applicant requesting a hearing.

**Discussion/Action Taken:** Commissioner Jones motioned to uphold the denial of Ms. Reyes Carillo's server permit application. Commissioner Kaegi seconded the motion, and the motion passed with two ayes.


