Subject: Commercial Fertilizer Values For 2014

Pursuant to § 43-11-110 of the Tennessee Commercial Fertilizer Law, the following values are announced for use in assessing penalties related to deficient fertilizer:

Nitrogen (N)	.55¢	\$11.00
Available Phosphorous (P)	.62¢	\$12.40
Potash (K)	.37¢	\$7.40
Calcium (Ca)	.34¢	\$6.91
Magnesium (Mg)	\$1.35	\$27.00
Sulfur (S)	.36¢	\$7.20
Boron (B)	\$4.19	\$83.80
Copper (Cu)	\$9.00	\$180.00
Iron (Fe)	.69¢	\$13.80
Manganese (Mn)	\$2.06	\$41.25
Molebdenum (Mo)	\$1.01	\$20.20
Zinc (Zn)	\$2.21	\$44.34

These values are state-wide averages taken from the Spring 2014 survey. They represent the average responses from throughout the state for retail value of commercial fertilizers.
