Description

Earning a CET certification will help students launch a successful and meaningful career that can help make a difference in countless lives. Whether seeking full-time or part-time employment, the opportunities in this profession are flexible and in high demand. The added skills of Holter monitoring and stress tests required for the Certified EKG Technician (CET) will help students to be even more competitive as they launch a healthcare career. There are no state agencies who have created the EKG technician training and certification requirements in Tennessee. The technician is categorized as an unlicensed assistive person (UAP) who is allowed to perform only those tasks that a licensed medical professional has deemed appropriate to delegate. Although the state has no formal governmental competency standards for the technician, employers often develop their own policies and procedures for the types of individuals who will be considered for open positions in the cardiac care unit.
