To fulfill T.C.A. § 49-6-7004 which was signed into law on April 17, 2012, local educational agencies (LEAs) were encouraged to develop and implement voluntary parental involvement contracts with the parents and guardians of the students. The purpose of the parent contract is to encourage and facilitate parent and guardian involvement with the student's education. The state law requires each LEA implementing parental involvement contracts to submit a copy of the implemented contract (district template) and the number and percent of parents signing the contract for each school. Although the use of parental involvement contracts is optional, Title-I Schools are required to distribute Parent-School Compacts annually. These compacts are different from the optional parental involvement contracts. The 2014-15 parent contract data received by the Tennessee Department of Education by May 15, 2015 is included in this report.
