Dear Ms. Whalen:

I am writing on behalf of the Tennessee Department of Education (TDOE) to request to waive § 421(b) of the General Education Provisions Act [20 U.S.C § 1225(b)] **to extend the period of availability of the 2012 fiscal year (FY) school improvement grant funds to September 30, 2017.** This waiver will allow any local educational agency (LEA) in Tennessee that received a School Improvement Grant (SIG) in the 2015-16 school year for its year three implementation to carryover any remaining FY 2012 funds to combine with its FY 2013 funds to sustain turnaround efforts for year four, the 2016-17 school year. Local education agencies (LEAs) will expend funds in accordance with the final requirements of the School Improvement Grant and the LEA's application for grant funds.

The TDOE assures that it has provided all LEAs in the state that are eligible to receive the School Improvement Grant with notice and a reasonable opportunity to comment on this request and has attached a copy of that notice and resulting comments. The TDOE further assures that it provided notice and information regarding this waiver to the public in the manner in which the state customarily provides such notice and information to the public (i.e. posting on the TDOE website).
