



# MIST Quick Tips Sheet for Students: Accessibility Features



**Flag Tool:** Flag an item you wish to return to later. You can also do this from the Review screen.




**Strikethrough Tool\*:** Scribble out some of the possible answers.



**Review Screen:** Select Review to view a list of answered, unanswered and flagged items.




**Highlighter Tool\*:** Select a word, or drag over a phrase, to highlight it. Select it again to remove highlighting.




**Navigation Tools:** Use the Previous and Next buttons to move through test questions.



**Calculator:** Select the calculator when you need assistance on math items.



**Reference Tool:** View a list of reference material available to help with the question or test.




**Zoom Tools:** Make text bigger or smaller - can be used multiple times.

**Line Reader Tool:** Select the Line Reader to focus on a single line of text to read. Select again to return to normal viewing.
