NOTICE OF HEARING

**Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation
announces a public hearing on water quality standards**

Triennial Review of Tennessee Water Quality Standards

The Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation (TDEC) will conduct a public hearing to solicit comments from the public regarding what revisions, if any, may be appropriate to Tennessee's water quality standards during a future formal rulemaking anticipated for 2017.

Water quality standards for surface waters are promulgated by the Tennessee Board of Water Quality, Oil, and Gas pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 69-3-105, and include Stream-use Classifications for Surface Waters (Chapter 0400-40-04), General Water Quality Criteria (Rules 0400-40-03-.01 to -.05), and the Antidegradation Statement (Rule 0400-40-03-.06). The agency does not anticipate reopening classifications and criteria for ground water at this time.

The main meeting will be in Nashville and will be teleconferenced with field offices across the state on December 15, 2016 beginning at 1:00 p.m. Central Time and 2:00 p.m. Eastern Time at the following locations:
