

**Tennessee Services • Training • Officer • Prosecution (STOP) Grants
Statistics Summary
FY2011 / FY2012 / FY2013**

STOP Grants promote a coordinated, multidisciplinary approach to improving the criminal justice system's response to violence against women. This approach envisions a partnership among law enforcement, prosecution, the courts, victim advocates and service providers to ensure victim safety and offender accountability. This grant program provides funding for projects that assist in efforts to reduce violence against women and men, specifically domestic violence, sexual assault, stalking, and dating violence.

Through an annual, federal STOP Formula Grant, Tennessee awarded 46 grants in FY 2010, 48 grants in FY 2011, 48 grants in FY 2012 and 34 grants in FY 2013.









STOP Victim Service Activities Order of Protection Assistance








STOP Prosecution Activities Order of Protection Assistance



STOP Prosecution Activities Referrals to Victim Service Providers




STOP Law Enforcement Activities
