

Sign Removal, TDOT General Specifications

- 1. The State will issue a purchase order to the vendor stating the type of sign to be removed and the sign location. Vendor will have 30 days to remove sign and transport to specified TDOT facility .**
- 2. The quantity of “each” refers to the “location of sign” – not each sign face.**
- 3. Remove all sign faces from device.**
- 4. Remove all catwalks from device.**
- 5. Remove all lighting and disconnect all power to the lighting.**

Note: Vendor must contact local service provider for electrical power, before power is disconnected.
- 6. Remove all pole(s) from device.**
- 7. Pole or poles are to be removed at least one (1) foot below ground level And backfill the hole from the removed pole leaving no part of the device above ground.**
- 8. Transport all components of the disassembled device to the nearest Tennessee Department of Transportation - TDOT district garage or TDOT regional facility without being destroyed. Transport location to be determined by TDOT personnel.**
- 9. Obtain all permits if necessary for the Transportation of all removed devices/ components.**
- 10. Comply with all worker safety and environmental regulations.**
- 11. Primary contractor must be on-site during all phases of the operation.**
- 12. This is a statewide contract. Terms and conditions are the same for all work, regardless of location.**
