

## ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Hallsdale Powell Utility District will receive separate sealed BIDS for the construction of the 2014 SRF Waste Water System Improvements – Dry Gap Pike Sewer Overflow Tank Project at the office of the General Manager until 10:00 am local time on June 25, 2015, and, then at said time, publicly open and read the BIDS aloud.

The work to be bid on is as follows: Construction of a 5,000,000 gallon sewer overflow tank and associated 36” diameter gravity sewer, a sewage pump station, electrical building on-site water and sewer piping, and site grading and related appurtenances.

The allotted time for construction is 360 calendar days.

Neither the State of Tennessee nor any of its departments, agencies, or employees is or will be a party to this Invitation for Bids or any resulting contract(s) awarded by the Owner.
