Tennessee's Health Care Innovation Plan

- Tennessee's draft Health Care Innovation Plan was released for stakeholder comment on Monday, December 9th. The plan outlines the state's strategies for health care payment and delivery system reform and explains how our work will ultimately improve population health, quality of care, and the cost-effectiveness of care for all Tennesseans
- This document will be submitted to the Center for Medicare and Medicaid Innovation (CMMI) on January 31st, 2014, as a condition of Tennessee's State Innovation Model (SIM) design grant award
- The innovation plan will be the basis for Tennessee's submission of a testing grant application for federal implementation funding in 2014
- We will continue to accept feedback from stakeholders on the plan through Wednesday, January 15th



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Direct provider communications: Payer to provider outreach

- Primary communications on the initiative will be lead by the MCOs and commercial payers
- Communications to providers will include:
 - Provider report delivery
 - Re-contracting discussions
 - Provider education on episodes, including targeted outreach to high-volume providers, hospitals and physician groups
- The timeline for outreach will begin with the release of the first reports and continue throughout 2014

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Direct provider communications: State to provider outreach

- The state will support payer outreach to providers through presentations to specialty societies and other provider associations

- The state will also be partnering with the MCOs during quarterly meetings to discuss the health care innovation initiative with providers
 - Meetings are scheduled to begin the week of December 2nd and extend through the first quarter of 2014

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Educational materials

- Provider and payer stakeholders have requested the State make available more materials that can be shared with providers and the public
- The state will develop educational materials for the program's rollout including:
 - Revised white paper
 - Episode descriptions for providers
 - FAQs on retrospective episode-based payments, PCMH and Tennessee's Health Care Innovation Initiative
- The state will also consider providing additional materials including:
 - Articles for provider association newsletters
 - Training webinars on episodes/PCMH
 - Success stories from Arkansas

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Utilize website and stakeholder email distribution to announce new material

- The broad stakeholder engagement throughout the initiative has generated a mailing list of over 300 interested parties, in addition to over 2,000 provider emails available through the TennCare provider list serve
- The list is currently used primarily to update the public on upcoming roundtable events
- Going forward, the state will utilize this distribution list, TennCare's provider list serve, and the payment reform website to update individuals on broader meetings and the initiative in general

Public outreach through email distribution list

- Release of new educational materials (white paper, training webinars)
- Notice of public meetings on the initiative
- Tennessee's Health Care Innovation Plan

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- The next provider stakeholder group meetings are scheduled for January 29, 2014 and February 26, 2014
