

Amended Policy Statement

The Board of Chiropractic Examiners adopted the following amended policy statement on November 9, 2004, which was further amended January 1, 2007.

A Chiropractic Physician licensed in Tennessee is required to complete twenty-four (24) clock hours of Board approved continuing education annually.

Should the Tennessee licensed Chiropractic Physician fail to obtain the required amount of continuing education during the calendar year, the following shall occur: 1. The licensee must pay a civil penalty in the amount of six hundred dollars (\$600.00) and payment rendered within 30 days upon notification from the Board. The licensee must make up the amount of hours that he/she is deficient in addition to the continuing education hours necessary to be obtained annually. The deficient hours must be made up within the following calendar year. Documented proof of the deficient hours obtained must be submitted to the Board upon completion. Failure to fulfill these conditions may result in disciplinary action. Failure to respond and obtain the deficient hours after receipt of notification, may result in additional and/or other penalties.

*A licensee is exempt from the continuing education requirements for the calendar year that he/she is licensed. Waiver of continuing education may be granted as stated in Rule 0260-2-.12 (7) (a) – (c).
