**APPLICATION ARCHITECT POSITION**

The Department of Revenue is currently seeking experienced candidates for an Application Architect. This is an Executive Service position and is located in downtown Nashville.

The Application Architect position is in the Department of Revenue's IT division and directs all IT activities related to Application Architecture for the Department of Revenue. The Department of Revenue's IT division has more than 85 employees statewide with roles in IT programs and operations. The Application Architect will be an integral part of the IT senior management team and its efforts to implement the department's strategic and operational goals.

The Application Architect provides technical support and leadership to current environments in support of the core business functions and influences the future direction of technology by performing duties including: making strategic decisions regarding software procurement; leading teams of business and technical personnel through the full system lifecycle in support of the achievement of business requirements; providing technical leadership and mentoring across the application development team; acting as a manager to supervise subordinate professional technical staff.

The Application Architect's duties and responsibilities, include, but are not limited to the following:

- Troubleshoots application problems by working with appropriate teams to diagnose and recommend solutions
- Provides guidance to development team to insure consistent look and feel of components, utilization of implementation patterns, and consistent use of tools
- Works with application team to insure the compliance of security policies and standards in the application design
- Ensures the testing methodology properly tests all components of an application
- Develops programming and development standards, policies, and procedures for use within the application
- Works with vendors to identify products which could provide potential solutions to business needs
- Plans the application development and deployment strategy and timeline which can include proof of concept, pilot, conversion, upgrade, and rollout
- Interacts with project managers, business analysts, functional experts, or other key personnel to understand and validate user requirements and insure the application design meets the requirements

**Education and Experience:** Graduation from an accredited college or university with a bachelor's degree and six years of professional level experience in information technology is preferred.
