- Provide a family with a home visitor every week to provide parent coaching, and strengthen parents' bond with their young baby

- Pay for four Tennessee children to receive one book per month delivered to their home for an entire year
- Purchase helmets for 7 epileptic children who can't afford them
- Provide an eye exam and glasses for a child in need


