NHC HealthCare Kingsport, LLC, Kingsport (Sullivan County), TN — CN1601-003

The addition of 8 new Medicare only certified SNF nursing home beds to the existing 52-Medicare only nursing home bed complement of NHC, Kingsport located at 2300 Pavilion Drive in Kingsport (Sullivan County), TN, 37660. The project includes minor renovation to accommodate the additional 8 beds. If approved, the total licensed bed complement will increase to 60 Medicare certified SNF beds. The estimated project cost is \$109,800. These 8 additional beds are subject to the 2015-2016 125 Nursing Home Bed Pool.

This annual fiscal impact projection assumes the current reimbursement rates as indicated below, 70% utilization by Medicaid patients unless otherwise known, and no patient income component. Because dually certified beds may be used for either Medicaid or Medicare reimbursement, a range of the fiscal impact is shown.

NHC HealthCare Kingsport, LLC, Kingsport (Sullivan County), TN — CN1601-003

The addition of 8 new Medicare only certified SNF nursing home beds to the existing 52-Medicare only nursing home bed complement of NHC, Kingsport located at 2300 Pavilion Drive in Kingsport (Sullivan County), TN, 37660. The project includes minor renovation to accommodate the additional 8 beds. If approved, the total licensed bed complement will increase to 60 Medicare certified SNF beds. The estimated project cost is \$109,800. These 8 additional beds are subject to the 2015-2016 125 Nursing Home Bed Pool.

Humphreys County Nursing Home, Waverly (Humphreys County), TN — CN1511-049

The relocation of Humphreys County Nursing Home, a 66 bed dually certified non-profit nursing home, and the addition of 25 beds from the 2015-2016 Nursing Home Bed Pool. The facility will be relocated approximately 2 miles to an unaddressed 15.4 acre site located on the east side of Fort Hill Road approximately 500 yards north of Hillwood Drive in Waverly, TN. As part of the project, the applicant seeks approval to increase its licensed bed complement from 66 to 91 total beds in a new one-story 59,000 gross square foot facility with 71 private and 10 semi-private rooms focusing on improvements that incorporate a modified Green House Concept. The estimated project cost is \$14,875,239.

West Tennessee Rehabilitation Center, Jackson (Madison County), TN — CN1510-044

The establishment of a 48 bed rehabilitation hospital to be constructed on a 5.58 acre site adjacent to the main hospital campus of Jackson-Madison County General Hospital. The applicant is jointly owned by Jackson-Madison County General Hospital District and HealthSouth Corporation with management by HealthSouth. If approved, upon completion of the request, Jackson-Madison County General Hospital will delicense its 48 inpatient rehabilitation beds. The estimated project cost is \$28,276,777.

TriStar Horizon Medical Center, Dickson (Dickson County), TN — CN1510-047

The initiation of neonatal intensive care unit (NICU) services in a 6-bed Level II neonatal nursery through renovation of existing space on the 2nd floor of Horizon Medical Center located at 111 Highway 70 East in Dickson, Tennessee. The project does not involve a change to the hospital's existing 157 licensed bed complement, the acquisition of major medical equipment or the initiation or discontinuance of any other health service. The estimated project cost is \$975,500.

Sumner Regional Medical Center, Gallatin (Sumner County), TN - CN1508-029

To establish a 5 treatment room free-standing, off-campus hospital emergency department. The proposed satellite emergency department will operate as a department of the hospital and is planned to be located at Sumner Regional Medical Center's existing outpatient facility known as Sumner Station located at 225 Big Station Camp Boulevard, Gallatin (Sumner County), TN 37066 which is located 6.9 miles west of the main campus. The estimated project cost is \$7,081,754.

TriStar Summit Medical Center Emergency Department at Mt. Juliet, Mt. Juliet (Wilson County), TN - CN1508-031

To establish an 8 treatment room free-standing, off-campus hospital emergency department to be constructed at an unaddressed site in Wilson County in the southwest quadrant of the intersection of I-40 and Beckwith Road (near Exit 229). The site is approximately 100 yards west of Beckwith Road on an access drive at Smyrna Ready Mix, whose address is 4910 Beckwith Road. The satellite emergency department is located approximately 9.9 miles east from TriStar Summit Medical Center. The estimated project cost is \$11,106,634.

Stones River Manor, Murfreesboro (Rutherford County), TN - CN1506-026

The establishment of a 30 bed Medicare-certified skilled nursing home located at 205 Haynes Drive, Murfreesboro (Rutherford County), TN 37129. The estimated project cost is \$2,729,126.75.

TriStar Summit Medical Center, Hermitage (Davidson County), TN — CN1505-020

TriStar Summit Medical Center seeks approval for the addition of 8 inpatient rehabilitation beds and 2 medical/surgical beds. It will delicense 6 obstetric beds by converting 6 Labor/Delivery/Recovery/Postpartum (LDRP) beds to LDR so the net increase will result in only four additional licensed beds, resulting in an increase in bed capacity from 196 to 200. The project involves renovations of existing patient floors to include the addition of the beds. The estimated project cost is \$4,892,904.

Regional Hospital of Jackson, Jackson (Madison County), TN — CN1505-022

Regional Hospital of Jackson seeks approval for a major construction project requiring a capital expenditure greater than \$5 million for the following: 1) renovation of approximately 9,294 SF in the existing surgical department; 2) the addition of approximately 3,777 SF of new construction to the existing surgical department; and 3) the addition of 2 operating rooms, increasing the number of operating rooms from 6 to 8. If approved the hospital will de-license 2 inpatient beds. The estimated project cost is \$8,864,901.
