Applications will be heard **July 22, 2015 Meeting** at the Tennessee Health Services and Development Agency Meeting (except for projects noted as **Consent Calendar** which will be heard at the **June 24, 2015 Meeting**).

This is to provide official notification that the Certificate of Need applications listed below have begun the review cycle effective **May 1, 2015**. The review cycle includes a 60-day period of review by the Tennessee Department of Health, the Tennessee Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services, or the Tennessee Department of Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities. Upon written request by interested parties the staff of the Tennessee Health Services and Development Agency shall conduct a public hearing. *Certain unopposed applications may be placed on a "consent calendar." Such applications are subject to a review less than 60 days including a 30-day period of review by the Tennessee Department of Health, the Tennessee Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services, or the Tennessee Department of Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities. Applications intended to be considered on the consent calendar, if any, are denoted by an asterisk.*

Pursuant to T.C.A. Section 68-11-1609(g)(1), any health care institution wishing to oppose a Certificate of Need must file a written objection with the Tennessee Health Services and Development Agency and serve a copy on the contact person for the applicant no later than fifteen (15) days before the agency meeting at which the application is originally scheduled for consideration.
