## *ST. PATRICK'S DAY HOLIDAY HISTORICAL INFORMATION*

### **2014 ST. PATRICK'S DAY HOLIDAY 12 AM, SUNDAY, MARCH 16 – 11:59 PM, MONDAY, MARCH 17 48-HOUR HOLIDAY PERIOD**

In Tennessee, there were four fatal crashes resulting in four deaths, yielding a fatality rate of one death every 12 hours.

Three crashes were single vehicle crashes; One was a multiple vehicle crash.

One of the fatalities (25%) occurred in an alcohol-related crash.

All of the four fatalities were vehicle occupants.

- None of the four (0%) were wearing safety restraints.

No motorcyclists, ATV riders, or non-motorists were killed.
