

STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION'S ROLE



SBE'S VISION

Maintain Tennessee's position as the fastest improving state in the nation – and enter the top half of all states on student outcomes by 2020.

This means the State Board of Education must develop and maintain policies which ensure a primary focus on student success.

Guiding Principles: Transparency and Serve ALL Students



MASTER PLAN

 - ✧ Top half on 2019 NAEP
 - ✧ ACT of 21
 - ✧ Post-secondary completion rates
- Strategic priority areas
 - ✧ Great Teachers and Leaders
 - ✧ High Quality School Options
 - ✧ High Standards and Quality Measures
 - ✧ Public Engagement and Oversight
- Annually revisit key policy levers

2017 DRAFT PRIORITIES

1. Teacher preparation – oversight and annual reviews (~5.9)
2. Teacher preparation report card – (~5.1)
3. Educator licensure requirements – (~5.0)
4. ESSA and accountability framework – changes and policy language – (~4.7)
5. Charter authorizing – (~3.7)
6. Leader preparation – (~2.5)
7. High School redesign and post-secondary pathways – (~2.1)
8. Others?

FEEDBACK TRENDS

Meeting preparation

- ◆ 1-on-1 calls after materials are sent out
- ◆ Box account and paper options
- Standardize format for policy proposals: 1) challenge/opportunity, 2) research/evidence, 3) proposal/recommendation

Workshops

- ◆ Discussion-style
- ◆ Ability to make suggestions for future topics
- More discussion of items on agenda (*also the opposite recommendation)
- Discuss all licensure actions with full documentation
- Keep agenda to key topics for deeper discussion

- Send schedule of regional meeting opportunities (SSC, others) to each member
