
### Project Update

The first months of 2015 have been challenging for construction. Winter storms and spring rains have hampered progress on the project, but crews have worked to maximize production during warmer, drier days.

Bell & Associates is nearing completion of the new water line system. In the coming weeks, crews will finish installation and mandated testing of the system on Memorial Boulevard, Ridgely Road, and College Street.

Murfreesboro Electric Department is also in the final stages of work. Only three aerial service lines remain to be converted to the new underground system. Once completed, the old power lines and utility poles will be removed from the work zone.

AT&T continues efforts to pull and splice new fiber optic and copper communication lines along Broad Street and Memorial Boulevard.



By the end of the month, S&W Contracting will complete installation of temporary traffic signals and roadway lighting at the Broad and Memorial intersection. The existing signal poles will be removed to allow widening of the roadway and building of the ramps as planned. The temporary signals will remain functional through much of the remaining construction.

As utility relocations are completed, activity will increase, specifically along the east side of Broad Street where widening will begin. Construction on the ramps and retaining walls will also get underway.

As always, motorists are urged to use caution, reduce speed, and be alert to changing road conditions in the construction zone.
