



Lebanon Town Square Reconstruction

Project Update

Since October 2014, the primary focus of work has been on the inner square. Parking spaces surrounding the statue of General Robert Hatton have been removed. Old concrete islands have also been removed, and new islands have been poured and set. Most noticeable, the traffic lane in the center of the square is now complete.

With the start of the New Year, contract crews are ready to begin Phase 2 of construction, which will focus on the outer square.

Before construction can begin, a portion of the road surface will be removed through a process called milling. During the prep work, the square will be closed to all traffic for approximately 36 hours. When the square reopens, traffic will be shifted and parking patterns will be adjusted.

The new traffic pattern will provide a lane of travel in the center of the square. Parking on the outer square, near business fronts, will be accessible with specific entrance and exit points. These changes are in line with the final design.



In addition to the new traffic pattern, at least one quadrant of the square will be closed for reconstruction for the remainder of the project. Work will begin in the northwest quadrant, at the corner of West Main Street and North Cumberland Street. From there, crews will work in a clockwise pattern, until work is completed in the southwest quadrant. Each quadrant will take approximately four to six weeks to complete. All businesses will remain accessible during construction.

The upcoming work will bring about significant changes to the current flow of traffic. Signage, pavement markings and construction barrels will be used to provide direction through the work zone. Law enforcement will also be utilized for safety. Motorists are urged to use caution, reduce speeds, and be alert to the changing traffic patterns.

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Square Closure Plans

- Saturday, January 17, 5 p.m., all square parking blocked
- Sunday, January 18, 6:30 a.m., square closed for milling
- Monday, January 19, 6 a.m., square reopened with new traffic and parking pattern, northwest quadrant to remain closed for construction

**In the event of inclement weather, all work will be rescheduled to the following weekend.*

Key Project Events

- Phase 2 milling of outer square
- Traffic shifted to inner square
- Reconstruction of outer square
- Corners of square closed for 4-6 weeks each for reconstruction, beginning in northwest quadrant and ending in southwest quadrant
- Nightly lane closures possible during construction
- Project completed June 2015
