

NOTICE OF AMENDMENT
STATE TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM

The Tennessee Department of Transportation is seeking comments on Amendment #209 to the 2014-2017 State Transportation Improvement Program. Amendment #209 is for Cheatham County project number 1411010 which extends from SR-12 to I-24. It is a Transportation Planning Report Option 4 for spot improvements to SR-49. Fiscal year (FY) 2017 Surface Transportation Program (STP) funding is provided for right-of-way (ROW). With FY 2015 STP funds already programmed in the STIP for this phase, the total ROW is now \$9,100,000. The latest estimates for project phase cost brings the total project cost (\$44,034,000) to almost twice the previous amount. The project will consist of adding passing lanes in both directions at various points along the 9.65-mile-long SR-49 corridor. The project is to be let to contract by TDOT.
