## NOTICE OF ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURE

Upon the request of a company for confidential treatment of information pertaining to an agency audit, the matter will be referred to General Counsel or his/her designee as Hearing Officer to determine if a contested case will be convened and whether a protective order will be issued. The Hearing Officer is authorized to issue a protective order and to prepare the matter for a determination on the merits by the assigned panel of directors. All actions of the Hearing Officer on preliminary matters may be appealed to the panel of directors pursuant to TRA Rule 1220-1-2-.06(6), as appropriate.

## NOTICE OF ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURE

The Tennessee Regulatory Authority takes the following administrative action to ensure the efficient and timely resolution of matters brought before the agency. An interconnection agreement or an amendment to an interconnection agreement adopted by negotiation and submitted for approval pursuant to 47 U.S.C. § 252(e) will be reviewed by Authority staff and, if no grounds for rejection are found, will be posted upon the Authority's web site with a notice allowing directors or other interested parties to file an objection to the agreement within a specified time limit. If no objection is received within the time specified in the notice, the agreement will be deemed approved. If grounds for rejection of the agreement or amendment are found or if objections to the agreement or amendment are filed within the time limit, the petition for approval of the agreement or amendment will be placed on an appropriately noticed conference agenda for a decision by the assigned panel of directors.
