

TENNESSEE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE COMMISSION MINUTES THURSDAY, FEBRUARY 22 1:00 p.m.

The February 2024 meeting was held on February 22, 2024 at 1:00 p.m. in Nashville, TN. Chairwoman Roberts, Commissioner Tomita, and Commissioner Hamilton were present. In attendance on behalf of TABC staff were the following: Assistant Director Tabatha Blackwell, Counsel Stepp, Legislation, Policy and Communication Director Aaron Rummage, Deputy Chief Brent Clayton, and Chief Law Enforcement Officer Bond Tubbs.

However, Commissioner Tomita was not comfortable recommending approval of the application due to the timing of the funds and recommended denial of the application and the motion was seconded. The motion passed with three ayes.
