

# TENNESSEE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE COMMISSION AGENDA MINUTES THURSDAY, AUGUST 27 1:00 p.m.

The August 2020 meeting was held on August 27, 2020 at 1:00 p.m. in Nashville, TN. Chairman Skiles, Commissioner Roberts, and Commissioner Tomita were present. #### 6. MISCELLANEOUS

Director's Update

**Discussion/Action Taken:** Director Thomas updated the Commission on a couple of items. Director Thomas highlighted where staff has helped businesses navigate through the pandemic by helping them with outdoor spacing to comply with social distancing and then expediting these spacing plans through the agency's chain to get them approved quickly. The agency has also helped develop educational materials for these businesses to use. Director Thomas mentioned that businesses have been changing their models in other areas, such as from becoming a Limited Service Restaurant licensee to becoming a Restaurant licensee with us. However, these businesses must sign an affidavit that states they will comply with these license conversions while also providing sales figures to the TABC for review on a monthly basis. Director Thomas informed the Commission on new updated policies with the TABC on the law enforcement side after Governor Bill Lee asked all Tennessee law enforcement agencies to update their use of force and intervening policies last month. This includes making sure chokehold techniques are not used and that intervening policies be put in place if they were not already in place. Deputy Chief Brent Clayton spearheaded a review of our policies with Director Thomas signing off on the policies after review of them. The TABC will also follow new guidelines from the Tennessee P.O.S.T. Commission, which includes a number of things including new in-service trainings.

- Law Enforcement Update

<u>Discussion/Action Taken</u>: CLEO Tubbs updated the Commission on enforcement activity since the last meeting including statistics on the number of inspections conducted, citations issued, fine amounts, minor compliance checks and compliance rate, seizures, and personnel news. Tubbs also discussed the recent implementation of issuing regulatory citations, as cases have been scheduled or completed for hearing already. Tubbs also mentioned that investigations into direct shippers was still ongoing despite the ongoing pandemic.
