- An Area Plan is a detailed statement of how the AAAD expects to provides services for programs authorized through the Older Americans Act and State funded programs
- Area Plans cover a period of four years and are updated on annual basis Currently operating in FY 2019 – 2022
 - Annual updates for FY 2021 were received on April 1

Annual updates include:

- Review of accomplishments from previous year
- Performance measures for new fiscal year
- S Program planning
- Updates on staffing
- New fiscal year budget
- List of proposed sub-contractors

- AAADs must have an approved Area Plan in place in order to receive federal funds for the upcoming fiscal year
