



Livestock Dealer License Application 2026–2027

Pursuant to T.C.A. §44-10-203, every person who buys, receives, or assembles livestock for resale on that person’s account or on that of another person more than nine times in any 90-day period must obtain a livestock dealer license from the Department of Agriculture.

All current Tennessee Livestock Dealer Licenses expire June 30, 2026.
