



## Livestock Market License Application 2026–2027

Pursuant to T.C.A. §44-11-104, every person who operates a location where livestock is assembled and sold at public auction three or more times in the same calendar year or at any auction presenting 30 or more head of livestock must obtain a livestock market license from the Department of Agriculture. Prior to licensing, applicants must demonstrate capacity to practice proper sanitation measures for the control of animal disease and to provide adequate yarding, housing, holding, and feeding of livestock.

All current Tennessee Livestock Market Licenses expire June 30, 2026. Please fill out this form completely and attach all required materials.
