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### **PROCEDURE TO OBTAIN AERIAL APPLICATOR LICENSE & AIRCRAFT DECAL**

The "Tennessee Aerial Applicators Law" requires licensing of all applicators custom applying pesticides via aircraft. On the reverse side is an application for an aerial applicator (pilot) license, and also for the decal mandated for your aircraft flown in Tennessee. The licensing year is the same as the calendar year, and applications received after November 15 will be processed for the following license year. On your application, please be sure to note:

- 1) Your physical as well as mailing address, if different.
- 2) Your FAA license number and Social Security number, if different.
- 3) Your daytime phone number
- 4) Your aircraft number, in addition to the aircraft type.

#### **Please be sure to attach the following:**

- 1) Your proof of liability of insurance, with minimum coverage of \$100,000.
- 2) Check made payable to the "Tennessee Department of Agriculture." The fees are \$150 for each decal, and \$200 for each pilot license.
- 3) A letter from a resident agent, should you be physically located outside of Tennessee.
- 4) Proof of commercial agricultural certification, if not presently certified in Tennessee.

The Aerial license exam is offered at several remote locations across the state. The certification exam is \$25.00 per category and the aerial license exam is \$25.00. You may pay for your license and testing fees by American Express, Discover, Master Card, Visa, check or money order. Include the expiration date and the cardholder's name as it appears on the card.
