Renewals for the next year are emailed to the portal user on the account in May of each year. The fee is \$200.00 for each product. No fees for 25B products or MUP products, but registration is required.

Steps to register a product in TN:

1. Email this application, market labels, SDS (if available), and EPA-stamped supplemental registration form (if available) to **Pesticide.Products@tn.gov**.
2. Request an invoice. We will email you the invoice and instructions to pay.
3. A confirmation verifying your registration will be emailed to the portal user on the account upon approval.

Please attach additional sheets if necessary. Additional scents, colors, and weights are paid as one product (single EPA#) with (various scents, various weights, various colors added to the end of the product).

We also register adjuvants, surfactants, wetting agents, dyes, water conditioners, defoaming agents, soil amendments, and seed treatments that are added to agricultural crops, ponds, and fields in Tennessee.

All registrations expire on **June 30** of each year. Late fees of 50% are added to each product not postmarked by the June 30th deadline. Renewals may be processed online through the **Tennessee Department of Agriculture's licensing portal** (see links to portal below). Note that renewals typically are emailed out in **May**.

Discontinued Products:

Tennessee requires a one-year discontinuance policy for products. If you would like to discontinue products then write DISC beside the product on the renewal and pay the fee for this year, then next year it will roll off as cancelled.

Cancellations of Products:

If no product remains on the channels of trade, you may email a cancellation letter on Company Letterhead stating the product that you wish to cancel and that the product has not been sold in TN and is not in the channels of trade, and the company is no longer producing the product.
