APPLICATION FOR A RESTRICTED-USE PESTICIDE DEALER LICENSE

All businesses offering restricted-use pesticides for sale in Tennessee must have a valid pesticide dealer license. To obtain the license you will need to:

- 1) **Have at least one (1) full-time employee with Pesticide Dealer Commercial Certification, also known as Category 12. For information on testing in Tennessee, or obtaining reciprocity from another state, please call (615) 837-5148/391.**
- 2) **Enclose a fee of \$50.00. If you are renewing an existing license, and you fail to have your application postmarked by June 30, there will also be a late fee of \$25.00 due. Make your check payable to the “Tennessee Department of Agriculture.”**
- 3) **Enclose your restricted-use pesticide sales records for the prior 12 month period if you are renewing. Sales forms are available from the Department, or you may use a computer printout. Your records must include the purchaser’s name and PIN Number, the pesticide purchased, the quantity purchased, and the purchase date. Please print or type. Please send to the email justin.caldwell@tn.gov or mail to the address at the bottom of the of the form, attention “Pesticide Registration.” Submitting applications via postal mail may result in slower processing times.**
