Basic Eligibility Requirements

- Applicant must be a Tennessee resident.
- Applicant must have a current Tennessee Veterinarian license (level 2 accreditation).
- Applicant must have an active practice located in Tennessee dealing with cattle, goats, and/or sheep. Percentage of large animal applies to the applicant, not the clinic. Only one application per clinic is allowed.
- Equipment purchased must be located in Tennessee.
- Applicant must have the ability and financial capacity to complete the project.

Program Requirements

Application

1. Applications must be submitted during the application period October 1 – 7, 2022 during the same period.
2. Applications are not accepted by fax, email, or text.
3. Applications are ineligible if postmarked or received prior to October 1 and after October 7, 2022.
4. Applicant will be notified in writing of approval or disapproval.

Reimbursement

1. Receipts dated prior to October 1, 2022 are not eligible. **All items, regardless of backorder status, must be purchased by the program reimbursement deadline.** Backordered items may be ineligible for cost share if not delivered to the farm by the program deadline.
2. Receipts must be in the name of the applicant approved for cost share funding.
3. Receipts for in-kind services are not eligible. Trade-in value is not eligible.
4. Used equipment, used materials, and leased equipment are not eligible for cost share reimbursement unless otherwise noted.
5. Labor provided by applicant is not eligible for cost share reimbursement. Labor is for structures only.
6. Applicant cannot be reimbursed for purchases from a business where applicant participates in ownership (producer cooperatives excluded).
7. Applicants cannot combine projects or attach items to another applicant's project. Applicants cannot submit multiple reimbursement requests for the same purchased item.
8. Reimbursement documentation must be postmarked by the reimbursement request deadline. Additional processing time is required for incomplete requests and requests submitted within one month of the program deadline. It is recommended you submit your reimbursement request as soon as your project is completed.
9. There can only be one reimbursement payment per program approval. Projects must be completed by reimbursement deadline.

Verification

1. Applicant must utilize equipment and structures reimbursed with cost share funds for the intended purpose of the program for a minimum of **five (5)** continuous years from date of purchase.
2. Site visits relating to the performance of the project before, during, and after completion may take place. Site visits may include verification of program eligibility to ensure applicants meet eligibility and minimum livestock/acreage requirements for chosen program(s).
3. Applicants may be required to repay funds if they fail to comply with all aspects of the cost share guidelines.
4. Providing any false, fraudulent, or misleading information may result in penalties and/or make the applicant's operation ineligible to participate in present and/or future Tennessee Department of Agriculture programs for a minimum of five years and may result in civil litigation or criminal prosecution.

Tennessee Department of Agriculture may:

- Accept, modify, or reject any or all requests.
- Modify program criteria, approval, and payment processes.
- Provide partial funding for specific activity components that may be less than the full amount requested.
 - Require additional information from the applicant.
 - Deny payments for projects that do not meet requirements.

ELIGIBLE ITEMS

- Head gate*
- Squeeze chute* (*carriage also eligible*)
- Palpation cage*
- Alleyway*
- Loading chute*
- Crowding tub*
- Corral Panels*
- Large animal scale
- Gates - interior use only; *must be installed at time of reimbursement*
- Cow lift – *to humanely move non-ambulatory animals*
- Calving Aids – *devices used to assist in delivery*
- Radio frequency readers – *must be capable of reading animal identification approved by USDA*

- Electro ejaculator and leads
- Semen collection device and holder
- Microscope
- Warming stage for cold weather
- Ultrasound and accessories – *must be at least 50% large animal (cattle, goats, and sheep)*
- Equipment for small ruminant artificial insemination – *examples include, but are not limited to, laparoscope, endoscope, cradle, and semen tank*
- Mobile veterinary unit inserts
- Portable lab equipment for on farm testing – *must be at least 50% large animal (cattle, goats, and sheep)*
