Master Certification & TAEP 50% Cost Share

To be eligible for 50% cost share, an approved applicant must complete an eligible master producer course prior to submission of reimbursement request.

- Certificates must be issued 2019 or after to be considered current for TAEP.
- Current certificate must be in the name of the applicant approved for cost share. No substitutions allowed.
- Copy of current certificate must be submitted with reimbursement request.

Master Producer Recertification

If you received your master certification after **January 1, 2019**, you will be eligible for 50% cost share for the 2022-2023 TAEP program. **Recertification is required if course was completed prior to 2019.**
