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RECEIVER'S MOTION TO DISPOSE OF STONE MARKERS AND EQUIPMENT  
 ON THE CEMETERY PREMISES, AND  
 TO APPROVE RECEIVER'S PROCEDURE TO ADDRESS OTHER REMAINING CARVED  
 MARKERS

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COMES NOW, Julie Mix McPeak, Commissioner of the Department of Commerce & Insurance, as statutory Receiver of Galilee Memorial Gardens (and the related entities through which it does business, JM&M Services, Inc., Lambert Memorial Co., Lambert Memorials, Inc., and Lambert & Sons, Inc.) (hereinafter "Cemetery") through her appointed Special Deputy Receiver, Receivership Management, Inc., by and through undersigned counsel, and hereby moves this Court for an Order approving the Special Deputy Receiver's request to dispose of stone markers and equipment on the Cemetery premises.

**PLEASE TAKE NOTICE: This Motion is addressed to the Individual Lamberts as potential respondents hereto, and to the one vehicle prior owner who has notified the Special Deputy Receiver that he is abandoning the vehicle in his name. If there is no opposition to this motion filed timely in the Court, this Motion may be granted without hearing, according to the Local Rules of Davidson County Chancery Court. (See Notice of Motion at End).**

#### INTRODUCTION REGARDING REMAINING PHYSICAL PROPERTY ITEMS

It is the Receiver's position that any such remaining property items are part of the Cemetery business and the entities in receivership, or ought to be deemed such, and thus within the Receivership which allows the Special Deputy Receiver to arrange their disposal or sale. Since the outset of this Receivership, there have been uncut granite markers, granite dies (the portion of a traditional headstone that stands up and sits on the base), and granite bases, as well as granite vases, left on premises of the Cemetery. Similarly there have been vehicles, two of which remain to be disposed of, after the other was returned to its owner. (**Exhibit A** hereto).

These granite items and business equipment have previously been disputed, or rights in them reserved, by the Lamberts as the leftover property of the Lamberts' memorial business and not that of the cemetery. The Lamberts have not hired new counsel and so whether they would necessarily oppose this motion is unknown. The time is ripe to resolve this outstanding issue so that the Special Deputy Receiver may be free to dispose of the granite items and business equipment, to position the receivership for final wind-up steps and motions.

The receiver is already empowered to deal with property and business of the cemetery under Tenn. Code Ann § 46-1-312(a)(7) and other plenary powers granted under that section and the order of receivership in this case. Thus this motion entails asking the Court to first find,

consistent with the receiver's determination, that the granite inventory items are property of the cemetery, or otherwise part of the operations of the cemetery business. This will affirm these are within the disposition power of the receiver to effectuate the wind up of the cemetery's affairs and clean up the premises. This motion second asks the Court to grant the receiver power to dispose of the particular items identified in the manner set forth below.

NOTE: Reminder, this motion is different from the subject of the prior Order Approving Procedures for Setting Markers at Galilee Memorial Gardens entered on June 5, 2017 that approved procedures that permitted the receiver to set markers on existing graves. Further, this Motion deals with other stones on the premises of the Cemetery that have names or identification on them, but do not belong in the Cemetery as they are not of the physical type and pattern that was used in the Cemetery.

**I. REMAINING PHYSICAL ITEMS ON PREMISES SHOULD BE  
DISPOSED OF BY RECEIVER**

Consistent with the Order for Receivership and Injunction in this matter, the identified entities and business names associated with Galilee Memorial Gardens cemetery, were regarded collectively as the Cemetery in receivership. That Order appointed the Commissioner as statutory Receiver of Galilee Memorial Gardens and the related entities through which it does business, JM&M Services, Inc., Lambert Memorial Co., Lambert Memorials, Inc., and Lambert & Sons, Inc. (which were designated collectively as the Cemetery). It has remained the Receiver's view that these entities, to the extent that they existed, were appropriately included within the receivership and all represented facets of the Cemetery's financial business. Because the entities were found and reported previously to lack monetary account assets, the question has mainly been academic. However, there are physical materials that must be disposed of.

As outlined in the initial Petition in this matter, the dealings of those entities (the memorial business and the cemetery business) were intertwined so that no reasonable distinction can be made between the assets of one and the other. This is supported by the fact that the granite and truck, as described below, were located at the cemetery, although the Lamberts have previously averred that they had a separate location where they operated their stone cutting business. It is further supported by the record in this matter, which shows that the Lamberts used numerous businesses, entities, and names interchangeably for the purposes of operating the Cemetery:

1. Lambert & Sons, Inc. – Paragraph 10 of the Affidavit of Robert Gribble, filed on January 24, 2014 as Exhibit 1 in support of the Petition in this matter, (“Gribble Affidavit”) states the wire transfer from Regions Bank to the Commercial Bank & Trust Company for the improvement care trust fund, came from an account held in the name of “Lambert & Sons, Inc.” This is supported by Exhibit 11 thereto, showing Lambert & Sons, Inc., and an address at the same 8283 Ellis Rd., checking account, as of 10/24/2013. Further, there is no information supporting that this is a valid Tennessee entity and, as such, based on the foregoing it appears to be an assumed name of the Lamberts in operating the Cemetery. JM&M Services, Inc. was the name that Lambert & Son, Inc. was amended to at the Secretary of State’s office on 12/13/2010.
2. Lambert Memorials, Inc. –All the receipts attached to the Affidavit of Roy Bozeman, filed as Exhibit 2 in support of the Petition in this matter, are issued by “Lambert Memorials Inc.” PO Box 140363, Memphis, Tennessee 38114 (901) 372-8357 to the various funeral homes. This demonstrates that the Lamberts used this entity extensively in their operation of the Cemetery. There is no entity of this name registered currently or in the past under this name. While there was a previous entity registered as Lambert Memorial Gardens, Incorporated, that entity was administratively dissolved in 2001 and was first registered in 1993 and Jesse Lambert, the prior owner of the Cemetery who passed away in 2010, still appears as the Registered Agent. As such, it does not appear to be a valid corporation for the operation of any business.

3. JM&M Services, Inc. – This was a corporation which appears to have been created in order for the Lamberts to apply for a registration to operate the Cemetery prior to the beginning of this Receivership. This entity was applying to register as of August 28, 2013, as demonstrated by Exhibit 6 to the Gribble Affidavit. In its January 16, 2013, application for registration, as shown by Exhibit 4 to the Gribble Affidavit, the Lamberts themselves indicated that it was formerly “Lambert & Son, Inc.”
4. JM&M Inc. was a fictitious non-entity that made application to operate the cemetery on or about August 31, 2011, as demonstrated by the Gribble Affidavit. The Lamberts made application in this name to register the Cemetery.
5. Lambert Memorial Co. is not a valid Tennessee entity and no bank accounts were located in its name when Special Deputy Receiver Kustoff performed a search for accounts held by the Cemetery or its operators. As such, to the extent it may have been used in in the past, it appears to solely be as a d/b/a of the Lamberts or one of the above entities.

Given this information, it is clear that the Lamberts used a mixture of corporations and d/b/a's, all of which are identified as part of the receivership entities, without regard to any actual entity or division between the Cemetery and any other “monument business.” Instead, all of these entities were alter-egos of the Lamberts and, as such, it is just that this property, being kept on the Cemetery ground for apparent use at the Cemetery, should be treated as Cemetery property.

Together with the complete lack of any monetary assets belonging to the Cemetery for the current maintenance, operation or fulfillment of any future obligations of the cemetery, it is submitted that good cause and efficiency justify the disposition of the identified remaining stone items that are not designated as belonging to specific individuals, and that these be considered to be disposable for the benefit of the Cemetery, only.

GRANITE BASES: The Special Deputy Receiver is currently in the process of attempting to have previously cut granite markers that were placed in the storage building on the Cemetery

premises that belong in the Cemetery set in the Cemetery as previously noticed to and approved by this court. However, many of the bronze markers in that building belong in the Cemetery but are missing the granite mounting bases. As such, the Special Deputy Receiver would hereby **MOVE** this court to order that the granite bases be deemed the property of this Receivership so that the Receiver may use them to reset these bronze markers and, if any bases are left after that point, that the granite markers, granite dies, granite bases *not marked with the name of any individual*, markers, or any other similar merchandise may be sold at such price as the Special Deputy Receiver may negotiate. These items are listed in the inventory in **Exhibit A** attached, as GMG Granite.

**VEHICLES:** In addition, the following are shown on Exhibit A: A truck remains on the premises of the Cemetery that is equipped for the setting of stones. For the reasons set out above, the Receiver would hereby **MOVE** this Court to deem this white Dodge Ram truck, VIN number 1B6MC36C0RS681357, to be the property of the Receivership, such that the truck may be used in the setting of stones and sold by the Special Deputy Receiver at such price as may be negotiated. A second vehicle, a burgundy Nissan VIN number JN1HJ01F6PT098403 owned by Arecko Gipson, has been abandoned by the owner. The Special Deputy Receiver had sent a certified letter to that owner, and upon speaking with staff of the Special Deputy Receiver, the owner stated that the vehicle was not worth the towing bill and did not reclaim the vehicle. Accordingly the Special Deputy Receiver **MOVES** this Court for an order granting authority to sell and dispose of that abandoned Nissan as well. The other two vehicles that were on cemetery grounds have been returned to their owners.

The Receiver further **MOVES** that this Court authorize the Special Deputy Receiver to hold the funds from the disposition of the **Exhibit A** property as set out above and to expend such

funds on matters related to this Receivership, as the Receiver deems fit. The Receiver will notify this Court of the proceeds generated by such sales, if any, in its regular reports.

## II. PROCEDURE REGARDING MARKERS WITH NAMES

The Receiver, on the Cemetery premises, is also in possession of a number of stone markers that have already been carved with the names of certain persons. An inventory of those stones is attached hereto as **Exhibit B**. It is the Receiver's position that such markers should be returned to the family of those for whom the stone is marked, or such other person as may reasonably make good use of such marker for the memorialization of the individual named thereon. As such, regarding those markers with names, the Special Deputy Receiver would hereby propose and **MOVE** the Court to approve the following procedure for the disposition of such markers:

1. The Special Deputy Receiver will cause the inventory of stones to be posted on the website of Receivership Management, Inc., and the Department of Commerce and Insurance will cause the list to be posted on the Department's website.
2. That Department will issue a press release to media outlets, concentrating on those in the Memphis area, and through social media notifying the public that the list has been posted to the websites and that interested persons are encouraged to review the list and to contact Receivership Management, Inc., regarding making a claim to one or more stones. The Department will issue a second press release at least ten (10) calendar days following the issuance of the initial press release. The Special Deputy Receiver would submit in support of this approach the substantial funds spent in the furtherance of this Receivership, the lack of operating funds for the Cemetery, and that this approach is, in the opinion of the Special Deputy Receiver, at least as likely to bring notice to the public as publication in a periodical of general circulation at a much lower cost.

3. If the Special Deputy Receiver receives a single claim to a stone after thirty (30) calendar days have elapsed from the issuance of the initial press release and he believes that the claim is well-founded based on the totality of the information provided, the Special Deputy Receiver is authorized to allow such claimant to take possession of the stone.
4. If no claim is made to a stone after thirty (30) calendar days have elapsed from the issuance of the initial press release, the Special Deputy Receiver is authorized to have the stone removed from the premises of the Cemetery and disposed of as the Special Deputy Receiver sees fit, provided that the Special Deputy Receiver will make reasonable attempts to find a place where a person may claim the stone in the future.
5. If two (2) or more claims to a single stone are made within thirty (30) calendar days from the issuance of the initial press release, the Special Deputy Receiver shall attempt to resolve the dispute informally. If no agreement can be made regarding the disposition of the stone within fourteen (14) calendar days of the expiration of the initial thirty (30) day period then the Special Deputy Receiver shall bring the matter before this Court.

**WHEREFORE**, the Special Deputy Receiver requests that this Motion be granted and that the Court enter an Order deeming any granite bases, and any other granite without personal identifiers, items on the premises of the Cemetery, the stone-setting truck, and the abandoned Nissan, identified above, as property within this Receivership, and under the sole authority of the receiver to liquidate for the benefit of or to reduce further expenses to the receivership, and authorizes their use and disposition as set out in this Motion. Further, the Special Deputy Receiver requests that this Motion be granted to authorize the Special Deputy Receiver to follow the procedure set out herein for the distribution and disposition of all markers with the name of an individual thereon.


