 ON RECEIVER'S REQUESTS TO DISSOLVE CORPORATIONS AND ALL BUSINESS  
 ENTITIES IN RECEIVERSHIP AND OTHER MATTERS

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The Court has under submission a motion by the Petitioner and Receiver, Julie Mix McPeak, Commissioner of the Department of Commerce & Insurance, in her official capacity as Receiver of Galilee Memorial Gardens (and JM&M Services, Inc., Lambert Memorial Co., Lambert Memorials, Inc., and Lambert & Sons, Inc., the related entities through which it conducted its business), through counsel, to continue the previously set evidentiary hearing on March 25, 2019 to a later date, due to the press of conflicting urgent matters to be handled by

counsel within this same immediate period. The Commissioner/Receiver has also submitted a request to expedite the hearing of that motion.

Based on the statements and representations found in the Motion to Continue and the Motion to Expedite, the Court finds good cause has been shown for expedited consideration of the Motion and for this Court to grant leave to continue the 3/25/2019 hearing to a later date.

Accordingly, the Court grants the request for expedited consideration and the hearing originally set for 3/25/2019 is reset for Wednesday, April 10, 2019 in at 9:00 a. m. in this Court.

All filing deadlines associated with the originally set March 25, 2019 hearing remain unchanged.

The counsel for the Petitioner shall send a copy of this Order after entry to the individual Defendants by overnight courier to ensure that they receive notice of the Court's action as quickly as possible.
