The Emergency Communications Board (the Board) will convene a fiscal year two thousand twenty-five second quarter public special meeting of the board. This special meeting is being called to allow the Board to discuss the creation of a new committee focused on potential changes to the distribution of funds provided via T.C.A. § 7-86-130 and the comments provided at the public hearing regarding an increase to the 911 surcharge.

Board meetings will be conducted in person but also permit participation of the Board members by electronic or other means of communication if necessary. Members of the public may attend and participate in person or attend remotely via the appropriate online meeting link. Upon request, a member of the public may participate in the meeting by electronic means. Any board member or member of the public participating by electronic means shall be audible to the public at the location specified above.
