



The hotline provides 24/7 free and confidential support, prevention and crisis resources. Shortening the number to 9-8-8 is designed to make it easier for people to remember so they can quickly Under the law, states will be authorized to collect fees in order to ensure crisis

The path to the shortened 9-8-8 dialing code began in 2018 with the passage of the National Suicide Hotline Improvement Act. The Act directed the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) to study the use of a three-digit dialing code for the hotline.






