The Tennessee Emergency Communication Board (TECB) is focused on offering 911 training initiatives that ensure District and PSAP leadership and telecommunicators have the knowledge, skills and abilities required to improve emergency response outcomes. These training opportunities are made available through both the Virtual Academy online training program and in-person classroom offerings.


