ORDER

This matter came to be heard on the 6th day of April 2010, before the Honorable Chancellor Ellen Hobbs Lyle, upon Respondent **Kristy Wright's** motion to dismiss.

Pursuant to Rule 12 of the Tennessee Rules of Civil Procedure, and based upon the various pleadings, affidavits, filings, statements and representations made in open court by respective counsel for both sides, and the entire record as a whole, the Chancellor finds that the Motion is well taken, and should therefore be GRANTED.

Furthermore, the Chancellor having considered facts outside of the pleadings in this matter and making specific findings of fact in its conclusion, finds that Respondent Kristy Wright is NOT an

officer or director of any of the respondent companies, as was originally thought, averred, and alleged. Ms. Wright is found to merely be an employee of Smart Data Solutions, and nothing more, and should therefore be treated as an employee henceforth, and removed from the style of this action.

It is therefore, **ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED** that



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
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
