**INITIAL ORDER**

This contested case hearing was set to be heard on January 22, 2014, before Administrative Judge Richard M. Murrell, assigned by the Tennessee Secretary of State to sit on behalf of the Commissioner of the Tennessee Department of Commerce and Insurance, Insurance Division. Assistant General Counsel Ms. Robyn Ryan represented the Department of Commerce and Insurance in this matter. The Respondent Timia Pratt, represented herself.

Upon convening the hearing in this matter, the Respondent was offered the opportunity to agree to the voluntary revocation of her resident producer license number 2335778 and ineligibility for reapplication in the future to thereby avoid any civil penalties or investigative costs. Ms. Pratt agreed to the voluntary revocation and ineligibility from reapplication stating that she had not engaged in the insurance business for four years.

Therefore, it is determined that resident producer license number 2335778 should be revoked and that the Respondent be ineligible for reapplication.

It is so **ORDERED**.
