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**ORDER ADOPTING EXAMINATION REPORT WITH DIRECTIVES**

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Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. §§ 56-32-101, *et seq.*, the Insurance Division of the State of Tennessee Department of Commerce and Insurance (“Division”) has examined certain affairs of the Unison Health Plan of Tennessee, Inc. (“Company”), a health maintenance organization domiciled in the State of Tennessee. As a result of an examination conducted as of the 31<sup>st</sup> day of December, 2009, the examiner-in-charge filed with the Division, on the 25<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2011, a verified, written report on the examination, and a copy of that report has been sent to the Company. (The Report on Examination of the Company is attached hereto and marked as Exhibit A). The Division received no written rebuttal to said examination report from the Company.

Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. §§ 56-1-411 and 56-32-115, said examination report regarding the affairs of the Unison Health Plan of Tennessee, Inc., filed with the Insurance Division of the State of Tennessee Department of Commerce and Insurance on the 25<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2011, is hereby **ADOPTED** as filed with the following **DIRECTIVES**:

1. The Company is **DIRECTED** to comply with Tenn. Code Ann. § 56-2-104(a)(5)(A) by maintaining its principle place of business, primary executive, administrative and home offices, and all original books and records in the State of Tennessee.
2. The Company is **DIRECTED** to comply with Tenn. Code Ann. § 56-32-103(d) by filing a copy of all excess of loss insurance agreements that the company enters into with the Tennessee Department of Commerce and Insurance.




