To: All Tennessee Self-Insured Employers – Workers’ Compensation Self-Insured Program

Re: **2021 – Premium Tax Requirement**

- The Deadline is on or before **June 30, 2021.**

The Tennessee Department of Commerce and Insurance (“TDCI”) requires all self-insured employers that are qualified to pay self-insured premium tax to file their 2021 Premium Tax Invoice online through CORE or by sending a payment by check to the mailing address found on your premium tax invoice.

Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. §§ 56-4-207 and 56-2-305, failure to pay your premium tax invoice by June 30, 2021 subjects you to penalty and interest.

Additionally, your self-insurer’s certificate, authorizing you to self-insure for purposes of workers’ compensation, may be suspended or revoked for non-compliance.

REQUIREMENTS FOR SELF-INSURED WORKERS' COMPENSATION SINGLE EMPLOYER

(Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 50-6-405 and Tenn. Comp. R & Reg. 0781-01-83)

Premium Tax Requirement

To comply with the premium tax requirement, please pay your premium tax invoice online through CORE or by sending a payment by check to the mailing address found on your premium tax invoice.

Your premium tax payment is due on or before June 30, 2021.

Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. §§ 56-4-207 and 56-2-305, failure to pay your premium tax invoice by June 30, 2021 subjects you to penalty and interest.

Additionally, your self-insurer's certificate, authorizing you to self-insure for purposes of workers' compensation, may be suspended or revoked for non-compliance.

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
