		INSTRUCTIONS				

In order to renew your Home Improvement license, the following items must be in place:

- Renewal fee is \$200.00 for a two (2) year license, if received by the expiration date. Check or money order should be made payable to: "Home Improvement" and include your license ID number on the payment. Social Security Number will be used for identification purposes only and will not be a part of public record, pursuant 42 USC 666. License status may be checked at the Boards website or directly at: http://verify.tn.gov/
- Late penalty fee is \$10.00 per month, not to exceed three (3) months \$30.00. The license cannot be renewed if it has been expired in excess of ninety (90) days; must file a new initial application, which may be obtained by contacting the Board at 1-800-544-7693 or by visiting our website. May keep same ID# (See T.C.A. § 62-6-507)
- The renewal form must be complete. Answer questions 1 6; attach proof of insurance for general liability and workers' compensation, with the Board listed as certificate holder; attach documentation to any of the items checked "Yes"; \$10,000 financial responsibility, such as a surety bond, is needed unless current and on file; attach fee (renewal and any late fees); sign and mail to:

NOTICE: Effective July 1, 2007, changes in the contractor's law for home improvement requires the following:

- (1) Contracts: (1) Contracts must be in legible writing and contain the complete agreement between the owner and the home improvement contractor; (2) State the full names and addresses of all parties, the license number of the home improvement contractor, the date when executed by the parties and contain a description of the work to be done and the goods to be used; (3) Be completed in full without any blank spaces to be filled in after the contract is signed by the owner and clearly describe any other documents which are to be incorporated, and shall contain the following notice directly above the space provided for the signature of the owner: "NOTICE TO OWNER: Do not sign this contract if blank. You are entitled to a copy of the contract at the time you sign"; (4) Contain the approximate dates when the work will begin and be substantially completed; (5) Contain the agreed upon consideration for the work; (6) Contain a notice that all home improvement contractors must be licensed by the board and that any inquiries about a contractor should be transmitted to the board's office; (7) Contain all other matters upon which the parties lawfully agree; and (8) Not contain any power of attorney to confess judgment. No sales person, agent or employee of the contractor shall be authorized to make any changes in the agreement on behalf of the owner.
- (2) Advertising: When advertising, must include license ID number and follow guidelines from the law and rules.
- (3) Prohibited Acts Include: Mortgage notes preparation; failure to notify board of changes of ownership, name or address.
- (4) Business Locations: License required for each location.
- (5) Workers Compensation: Effective December 31, 2009, must provide coverage on yourself. (Public Chapter 1041)
- (6) Law and Rule Changes: Review from the website at: http://tn.gov/commerce/boards/contractors/
- (7) Change of Ownership: More than 20% requires obtaining a new license.
 - Name and Mode Changes: Must supply information relative to changes needed on license; may require a revised bond.

Coverage Determination – Questionnaire

(Required for Home Improvement Contractors NOT submitting Proof of Insurance)

The following questionnaire has been developed to assist licensees and our staff to determine whether proof of workers' compensation insurance coverage in needed in order to renew or obtain a license with the Tennessee Board for Licensing Contractors.

Effective March 1, 2011, Public Chapter 1149 requires contractors to supply proof of insurance coverage on themselves, in addition to their employees, unless they are exempt. A provision allows up to three (3) individuals as an **owner**, **officer**, **partner or member** to be exempt from coverage on themselves by registering each person on the license with the Tennessee Secretary of State as a "**Construction Services Provider**". Therefore, licensee applicants without employees have the option provide proof of insurance <u>or</u> proof of registration for exemption, unless considered exempt from both (*sole proprietors and partners without employees or subs, working directly for a residential owner*, etc.). As always, check with your insurance agent to make sure you are properly protected on a project. Questionnaire

1. If you check ONE of the following, you are NOT EXEMPT and must submit proof of insurance :				
- One or More Employees - Having more than as allowed for an exemption (three (3) owners or officers; or a partner retaining <u>less</u> than 30% ownership)

If you check ALL of the following, considered EXEMPT from submitting proof of insurance , and will need to supply proof of registration as a "Construction Services Provider" - http://tnbear.tn.gov/wc/ (Licenses expired cannot register as a licensee with the Board and would not qualify for \$100 discount with Secretary of State)				
- No Employees - Less than three (3) owners and/or /officers; if a partnership, each partners owns a minimum of 30% of business entity All owners/officers/members/partners are registered as a "Construction Services Provider" - Does not meet the criteria in section "3" below; see attached registration for each individual on license (limited to three) (Note: Partnerships will need to register with the Secretary of State's "Corporate" section to obtain a "Control #")				
3. If you check ALL of the following, you are EXEMPT from supplying proof of insurance and registration as a				
"Construction Services Provider" as a condition of licensure:				
- No Employees or Subs - Sole Proprietor; or Partnership with less than three (3) members - Does not perform commercial work and performs residential; works directly for the owner of project
