## **General Information**

Process: License must be active or have renewal rights in order to retire. Complete the above portion, sign and return with the nonrefundable \$50 retirement fee to retire for two (2) years (using same renewal biennial cycle). However, there is an option to retire from 1 to 7 years by paying \$25 for each year. If this is a new retirement request and your license is currently active, please include your current license and certificate and I.D. pocket card. If license is expired, less than 12 months, please submit renewal fee (\$200) and late fees (\$20/month) in addition to the retirement fee. Renewal fees paid prior to retirement are non-refundable. A contractor's license may be retired annually up to seven (7) years. To restart the 7 year cycle, must pay the \$200 renewal activation fee. If you are unsure how many years it has been retired, you may simply send retirement fee and if additional fees are required, you will be contacted. Please be sure to renew retirement prior to expiration date on license. You are not required to complete the Renewal form or provide insurance and a financial statement to place the license in retirement. Renewal notices are not sent to retired inactive licensees.
