

Update: COVID-19 GUIDELINES

On Monday, March 30, 2020, Governor Lee issued Executive Order No. 22, which directs Tennesseans to stay home unless engaging in essential activities to limit their exposure to and spread of COVID-19.

For the purposes of Executive Order No. 22, essential activities include critical trades. This includes, but is not limited to: building and construction tradesmen and tradeswomen and other trades, including, but not limited to, plumbers, electricians, exterminators and pest control, cleaning and janitorial staff for commercial and governmental properties, security staff, operating engineers, HVAC, painting, moving and relocation services, and other manufacturing, distribution, retail or service providers who provide services that are necessary to maintaining the safety, sanitation, and essential operation of residences. Essential Activity, and Essential Services, also includes electronic security and life safety services to assist with fire prevention and response, security, and emergency management and response.
