



FACT SHEET: Juveniles (Under 18 years old) under Tennessee Department of Correction Jurisdiction on June 8, 2019

The data used for this fact sheet has been extracted from the Tennessee Offender Management Information System (TOMIS) and summarized by Decision Support: Research & Planning of the Tennessee Department of Correction.



- Thirteen (13) juveniles were under TDOC jurisdiction on June 8, 2019.
- Twelve (12) juveniles were at the Northwest Correctional Complex in Tiptonville, TN and one (1) juvenile was at Sumner County Jail.
- Eleven (11) juveniles were 17 years old and two (2) juveniles were 16 years old.
- Primary Offense categories were Aggravated Robbery (5), Homicide (3), Attempted Aggravated Robbery (1), Robbery (2), Aggravated Rape (1), and Theft (1).
- Sentence range was 1 to 25 years for the thirteen (13) juveniles.
- Eleven (11) juveniles were Black/African American, one (1) juvenile was Hispanic, and one (1) juvenile was White.
- All thirteen (13) juveniles were Male.




