What is the TN NCSR?

What is the Purpose of the NCSR?

The NCSR is designed to help organizations **identify areas for improvement and capabilities** in their cybersecurity maturity in alignment with the National Institute of Standards and Technology Cybersecurity Framework (NIST CSF).

Receive no-cost support in completing the NCSR and access to suggested corrective actions, metrics specific to your organization to help you identify areas of improvement, prioritize next steps, and increase your cybersecurity maturity over time.

Completion of the NCSR makes you **eligible to receive State or Federally funded cybersecurity support and resources**, including the State and Local Cybersecurity Grant Program (SLCGP).
